My dear Mrs. Black:

Following our verbal agreement, I am sending this letter to you, as well as to the artists concerned, to confirm the understanding that the BELGIAN TRIO and Mr. William Hain will provide the program for Tuesday, October 16th, at 11 o'clock in the morning, here at Carrollcliff, and it is agreed that they will receive a total of two hundred (\$200.) dollars for their services. The final program is to be submitted to you within the next two or three weeks, as you said you would not need to have it before that time, but it will of course follow the lines which you and Mr. Emonts discussed on Tuesday at your house, and will last for about an hour and a half.

May I ask you to sign one of the copies of this letter in order that we may have it in black and white and return same to me, keeping one for yourself for reference.

I am sure we will have a very lovely program and I hope you will be well satisfied.
